The Globalization and Localization in Computer-Assisted Language Learning (GLoCALL) 2013 Conference was the seventh joint conference of the Asia-Pacific Association for Computer-Assisted Language Learning (APACALL) and the Pacific Association for Computer Assisted Language Learning (PacCALL). It was held in collaboration with the University of Foreign Language Studies at the University of Danang in Da Nang, Vietnam and attracted over 200 delegates from Australia, China, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Laos, Malaysia, The Netherlands, Oman, The Philippines, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, South Korea, Thailand, UK, USA and Vietnam.
